## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO REQUIRE ELECTION COMMISSIONERS TO FILE  
10 A STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL INTEREST; TO AMEND A  
11 PORTION OF ARKANSAS CODE WHICH RESULTED FROM  
12 INITIATED ACT 1 OF 1988; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

14 AN ACT TO REQUIRE ELECTION COMMISSIONERS  
15 TO FILE A STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-8-701(a), resulting from Initiated Act 1*  
23 *of 1988, concerning persons required to file a statement of financial*  
24 *interest, is amended to read as follows:*

25 (a) The following persons shall file a written statement of financial  
26 interest:

27 (1) A public official, as defined in § 21-8-402(17);

28 (2) A candidate for elective office;

29 (3) A district judge or city attorney, whether elected or  
30 appointed;

31 (4) Any agency head, department director, or division director  
32 of state government;

33 (5)(A) Any public appointee to any state board or commission  
34 that is authorized or charged by law with the exercise of regulatory  
35 authority or is authorized to receive or disburse state or federal funds.

36 (B) A public appointee to a state board or commission that



1 is not charged by law with the exercise of regulatory authority and that  
2 receives or disburses state or federal funds only in the form of mileage  
3 reimbursement for members attending meetings of the board or commission shall  
4 not be required to file a written statement of financial interest;

5 (6) All persons who are elected members of a school board or who  
6 are candidates for a position on a school board;

7 (7) All public and charter school superintendents;

8 (8) Executive directors of education service cooperatives; and

9 (9) Any person appointed to one (1) of the following types of  
10 regional, municipal, or county boards or commissions:

11 (A) A planning board or commission;

12 (B) An airport board or commission;

13 (C) A water or sewer board or commission;

14 (D) A utility board or commission; ~~or~~

15 (E) A civil service commission; or

16 (F) A board of election commissioners.
