- 6 (2)(3) "Format" means the organization, arrangement, and form of electronic information for use, viewing, or storage;

14	25-19-110. Adverse action against public employee prohibited.
15	A public employer shall not take adverse action against a public
16	employee because the public employee or a person authorized to act on behalf
17	of the public employee exercises any right or privilege provided a citizen
18	under this chapter.
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
