16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 1-5-106 is amended to read as follows:  
19 1-5-106. Memorial days generally.

20 The following days ~~shall not be~~ are not legal holidays but ~~shall be~~ are  
21 memorial days to be commemorated by the issuance of appropriate proclamations  
22 by the Governor:

24 (2) Thomas Paine Day - January 29;
