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18	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
19	General Assembly that the provisions of this act change the calculation of		
20	compensation for retirement purposes and should become effective on July 1,		
21	2009, for consistent application and to avoid confusion; and that unless this		
22	emergency clause is adopted, this act will not go into effect until after the		
23	beginning of the next fiscal year. Therefore, an emergency is hereby		
24	declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the		
25	public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and		
26	after July 1, 2009.		
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
