18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-59-248 is amended to read as follows:

21 20-59-248. Incidental sales of goat milk and whole milk that has not
22 been pasteurized are not prohibited.

23 (a) For purposes of this section:

24 (1) "incidental sales of goat milk" "Incidental sales" are those
25 sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold does not exceed one
26 hundred (100) gallons; and

27 (2) "Whole milk" has the same meaning as it is defined in § 20-
28 59-201.

29 (b) The provisions of this subchapter shall not be construed to
30 prohibit incidental sales of raw goat milk or whole milk that has not been
31 pasteurized directly to consumers at the farm where the milk is produced or
32 to preclude the advertising of those incidental sales ~~of goat milk~~.
