1 2 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. STATE 3 POLICE RETIREMENT FUND TRANSFERS. A sum not to exceed \$43,267 \$45,902 in the 4 5 2007-2008 2009-2010 fiscal year may be transferred from the State Police 6 Retirement Fund to the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System Fund for 7 costs incurred by the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System in 8 administering the State Police Retirement System. Such transfer request 9 shall be made to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and upon his 10 approval, said transfer shall be made on his books and those of the Treasurer 11 of the State and the Auditor of the State. 12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 13 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010. 14 15 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXEMPTION 17 FROM PRIOR REVIEW. The Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System is hereby exempted from seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council with 18 19 regard to transfers between the Benefits line item in the Cash Fund 20 Appropriation and the Benefits-Non-Employee line item in the Operations 21 Appropriation which are specifically related to transfers necessitated by the 22 changes in retirees' selection of the method of payment of retirement 23 benefits. All other provisions of Arkansas Code §19-4-522 shall be applicable. 24 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 26 2007 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010. 27 28 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 29 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 30 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 31

32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 33 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 34 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 35 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 36 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

2	SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
3	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
4	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
5	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
6	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
7	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
8	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
9	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
10	
11	SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
12	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
13	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
14	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
15	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
16	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
17	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
18	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
19	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
20	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
21	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
