## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE  
VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINING BOARD FOR THE FISCAL  
YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2010; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE VETERINARY MEDICAL  
EXAMINING BOARD APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
Veterinary Medical Examining Board for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the  
following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be  
governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
(Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions  
of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Veterinary Medical Examining Board for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Veterinary Medical Examining Board, to be payable from the Veterinary Examiners Board Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Veterinary Medical Examining Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

1 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

8 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
14 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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17 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
19 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of  
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
22 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
23 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the  
24 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
25 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
26 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
27 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
