9 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OR THE
10 JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE TO RECEIVE A MONTHLY
11 REPORT FOR COMMODITIES CONTRACTS THAT HAVE A
12 PROJECTED TOTAL COST OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND
13 DOLLARS (\$100,000) OR MORE; AND FOR OTHER
14 PURPOSES.

16 TO ALLOW THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OR THE
17 JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE TO RECEIVE A
18 MONTHLY REPORT FOR COMMODITIES CONTRACTS
19 THAT HAVE A PROJECTED TOTAL COST OF ONE
20 HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) OR
21 MORE.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
26

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-11-265, concerning the submission of
28 contracts to the Legislative Council or to the Joint Budget Committee, is
29 amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

30 (c)(1)(A) In addition to the contracts for technical and general
31 services that are presented to the Legislative Council or to the Joint Budget
32 Committee under subsection (a) of this section, the director shall compile a
33 monthly report of each commodities contract that has a projected total cost
34 of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or more.

35 (B) The director shall include in the monthly report under
36 subdivision (c)(1)(A) of this section a commodities contract that is procured



1 by a state agency with an agency procurement official.

2 (2) The monthly report shall include without limitation:

3 (A) The name of the contractor if the commodities contract
4 is a state contract;

5 (B) The state agency name if the commodities contract is
6 procured by a state agency with an agency procurement official;

7 (C) The contact information for the contractor or state
8 agency;

9 (D) The amount of the contract;

10 (E) The type of commodity or commodities contracted;

11 (F) The quantity of the commodity or commodities
12 contracted; and

13 (G) The procurement method.

14 (3) The director shall remit the report each month to the
15 Legislative Council or to the Joint Budget Committee as directed by the
16 Legislative Council.

17 (4) The Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee may
18 review or may exempt from review any commodities contract or group of
19 commodities contracts under this subsection.
