9 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OR THE
10 JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE TO RECEIVE A MONTHLY
11 REPORT FOR COMMODITIES CONTRACTS *INCLUDING*
12 *SERVICES* THAT HAVE A *PROJECTED TOTAL COST OF TWO*
13 *HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000) OR*
14 *MORE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.*

16 *TO ALLOW THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OR*
17 *JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE TO RECEIVE A*
18 *MONTHLY REPORT FOR COMMODITIES CONTRACTS*

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-11-265, concerning the submission of
27 contracts to the Legislative Council or to the Joint Budget Committee,
28 Is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

29 (c)(1)(A) In addition to the contracts for technical and general
30 services that are presented to the Legislative Council or to the Joint Budget
31 Committee under subsection (a) of this section, the director shall compile a
32 monthly report of each commodities contract that includes services and has a
33 projected total cost of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) or
34 more.

35 (B) The director shall include in the monthly report under
36 subdivision (c)(1)(A) of this section a commodities contract that is procured



1 by a state agency with an agency procurement official.

2 (2) The monthly report shall include without limitation:

3 (A) The name of the contractor if the commodities contract
4 is a state contract;

5 (B) The state agency name if the commodities contract is
6 procured by a state agency with an agency procurement official;

7 (C) The contact information for the contractor or state
8 agency;

9 (D) The total cost of the contract, the cost of the
10 commodities, and the cost of the services;

11 (E) The type of commodity or commodities, and services
12 contracted;

13 (F) The quantity of the commodity or commodities
14 contracted; and

15 (G) The procurement method.

16 (3) The director shall remit the report each month to the
17 Legislative Council or to the Joint Budget Committee as directed by the
18 Legislative Council.

19 (4) The Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee may
20 review or may exempt from review any commodities contract or group of
21 commodities contracts under this subsection.
