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SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHERS 10 11 FOR SENSORY IMPAIRED CERTIFIED MASTERS OR BACHELOR TEACHERS ENTERING STATE 12 SERVICE. Upon the superintendent's certification to the State Personnel Administrator of prior service at an educational institution-and most recent 13 14 contractual salary, the salary of teachers holding certification in teaching 15 the visually impaired and entering state service as teachers for the sensory 16 impaired may be adjusted to a rate of pay closest to but not less than their 17 most recent the annual salary they would have received from their previous 18 employer, effective upon employment at ASB.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

SPECIAL 33 RATES OF PAY. Due to the need to meet the minimum compensation schedule as 34 established by Act 74 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 84th General 35 Assembly, or its successor, for public school teachers, counselors, and 36 librarians and other education professionals as listed in subsection (a)

below, the Arkansas School for the Blind is authorized to adjust current or new employees to at least the minimum level of compensation for public school employees.

For current or new employees in the positions listed in subsection (a) below, the Arkansas School for the Blind may implement salary adjustments to maintain equity between their teacher salaries and those of Central Arkansas Public School Systems only after a plan for determining and implementing those adjustments has been reviewed by the Office of Personnel Management and by the Personnel Committee of the Arkansas Legislative Council and approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

For purposes of implementing the plan, the Arkansas School for the Blind
 is authorized special rates of pay up to Pay Level IV the maximum of the

6 Funding for the minimum compensation provided for in this section that is 7 supported in whole or in part from general revenues, shall, if required, be 8 provided by a transfer from the Merit Adjustment Fund to the proper fund or 9 fund account and in such amounts as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. The Arkansas School for the Blind shall, in addition to the funds 10 11 provided in this Act for Annual Career Service Recognition Payments from the 12 Merit Adjustment Fund, make available any funding generated from agency salary savings for such purposes from the funds or fund accounts as provided 13 14 by law.

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18 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 19 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 20 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 21 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

2.8 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 29 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 30 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 31 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 32 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 33 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 34 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 35 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 36

1	SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
3	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
4	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
5	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
7	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
8	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
9	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
10	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
11	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
