## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to provide additional contributions for HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS UNDER THE PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES, HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-1117(a) and (b), concerning contributions to health insurance premiums of public school employees, are amended to read as follows:
(a)(1) Beginning on October 1, 2004, local Each public school
districts district shall pay the health insurance contribution rate of one hundred thirty-one dollars (\$131) per month for each eligible employee electing to participate in the public school employees' health insurance program administered by the State and Public School Life and Health Insurance Board.
(2) To the extent an appropriation and funding are available for this purpose, the Department of Education shall pay to the Employee Benefits Division of the Department of Finance and Administration employer contributions in the amount required under this subdivision (a) for each participating employee of an educational service cooperative, secondary area
vocational center, and the Arkansas Correctional School.
(b) (l) (A) The Each fiscal year, the Department of Education shall pay to the Employee Benefits Division of the Department of Finance and Administration a minimum of sixty-one dollars ( $\$ 61.00$ ) per month for each eligible employee electing to participate in the public school employees' health insurance program administered by the State and Public School Life and Health Insurance Board division the full amount of an appropriation and funding for the purpose of making contributions to health insurance premiums for public school employees that are in addition to the employer contributions under subsection (a) of this section.
(B) The Department of Education shall make the total contributions under subdivision (a)(2) and subdivision (b)(1)(A) of this section by transferring thirty-five million dollars ( $\$ 35,000,000$ ) the funding to the division in eleven (ll) equal monthly installments.
(2) The board shall administer the funds provided to the division under subdivisions (a)(l) and (b)(l) of this section subsection shall be administered by the board for the benefit of the employee participants of the public school employees' health insurance program.
(3)(A) In the event that If an appropriation or funding is not provided for the contributions under subdivision (a)(2) or (b)(1) of this section, the department shall not be Department of Education is not responsible for the increased payments contributions under the unfunded subdivision for the public school employees' health insurance program as established by this section.
(B) If funding and appropriation are provided but are inadequate for the total number of employees electing to participate in the public school employees, health insurance program, the department shall pay a proportional share on behalf of each participant.
(C) If funding and appropriation are provided and exceed the amount needed to make the minimum contribution under subdivision (b)(1)(A) of this section, the department shall pay a proportional share of the excess on behalf of each participant.
