22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-1117(a) and (b), concerning
25 contributions to health insurance premiums of public school employees, are
26 amended to read as follows:

27 (a)(1) ~~Beginning on October 1, 2004, local~~ Each public school
28 ~~districts~~ district shall pay the health insurance contribution rate of one
29 hundred thirty-one dollars (\$131) per month for each eligible employee
30 electing to participate in the public school employees' health insurance
31 program administered by the State and Public School Life and Health Insurance
32 Board.

33 (2) To the extent an appropriation and funding are available for
34 this purpose, the Department of Education shall pay to the Employee Benefits
35 Division of the Department of Finance and Administration employer
36 contributions in the amount required under this subdivision (a) for each



1 participating employee of an educational service cooperative, secondary area
2 vocational center, and the Arkansas Correctional School.

3 (b)(1)(A) ~~The~~ Each fiscal year, the Department of Education shall pay
4 to the Employee Benefits Division of the Department of Finance and
5 Administration a minimum of sixty one dollars (\$61.00) per month for each
6 eligible employee electing to participate in the public school employees'
7 health insurance program administered by the State and Public School Life and
8 Health Insurance Board division the full amount of an appropriation and
9 funding for the purpose of making contributions to health insurance premiums
10 for public school employees that are in addition to the employer
11 contributions under subsection (a) of this section.

12 (B) The Department of Education shall make the total
13 contributions under subdivision (a)(2) and subdivision (b)(1)(A) of this
14 section by transferring ~~thirty five million dollars (\$35,000,000)~~ the funding
15 to the division in eleven (11) equal monthly installments.

16 (2) The board shall administer the funds provided to the
17 division under subdivisions (a)(1) and (b)(1) of this section ~~subsection~~
18 ~~shall be administered by the board~~ for the benefit of the employee
19 participants of the public school employees' health insurance program.
