22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
25 the State Board of Election Commissioners for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
34 101), or its successor.

 13 the State Board of Election Commissioners, to be payable from the
 14 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating
 15 expenses of the State Board of Election Commissioners for the fiscal year
 16 ending June 30, 2010, the following:

30 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - ELECTION EXPENSES. There is hereby
 31 appropriated, to the State Board of Election Commissioners, to be payable
 32 from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for covering the costs of
 33 election expenses by the State Board of Election Commissioners for the fiscal
 34 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of\$2,493,500.

36 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - NONPARTISAN JUDICIAL GENERAL ELECTIONS. There

1 is hereby appropriated, to the State Board of Election Commissioners, to be
2 payable from the Judicial Filing Fee Fund, for covering the costs of election
3 expenses by the State Board of Election Commissioners for the fiscal year
4 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of\$800,000.
5

6 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
8 FORWARD – ELECTION EXPENSES. At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30,
9 ~~2008~~ 2010, any unexpended balance of monies provided for Election Expenses,
10 shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for the
11 fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

12 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of ~~appropriation and/or~~ funding as
13 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

14 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2008~~ 2010 the Agency shall by written statement set
15 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said ~~appropriation and/or~~
16 funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

17 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
18 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward ~~from~~
19 ~~the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the~~
20 ~~biennium~~ by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
21 Committee meeting ~~in the second fiscal year of the biennial period~~ which
22 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
23 and the amount of the ~~appropriation and/or~~ funding carried forward ~~from the~~
24 ~~first fiscal year to the second fiscal year~~, the program name or line item,
25 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request
26 set forth in (1) above;

27 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
28 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
29 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
30 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
31 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
32 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
33 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
34 Committee; and

35 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
36 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals

1 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
 2 Institution.

3
 4 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF
 6 ELECTION EXPENSES APPROPRIATION. The funds appropriated for Election
 7 Expenses may be used to cover the expenses of the State Board of Election
 8 Commissioners and the county election commissions to conduct presidential
 9 preferential primary elections, preferential primary elections, general
 10 primary elections, special primary elections, nonpartisan judicial general
 11 elections, and statewide special elections.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
 13 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

14
 15 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 17 OF FUNDS. If the State Board of Election Commissioners is required to pay the
 18 expenses for any statewide special election or special primary election and
 19 funds are not available to pay for such elections, the Director of the State
 20 Board of Election Commissioners shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of
 21 the State the amount needed to pay the expenses of the election(s). Upon the
 22 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the amount certified shall
 23 be transferred from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund to the Miscellaneous
 24 Agencies Fund Account of the State Board of Election Commissioners. All
 25 unused funds transferred under this provision shall be transferred back to
 26 the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund at the end of each fiscal ~~biennium~~-year.
 27 The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall initiate the necessary transfer
 28 documents to reflect all such transfers upon the fiscal records of the State
 29 Auditor, the State Treasurer and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
 30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, 2009 through
 31 June 30, 2010.

32
 33 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 34 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 35 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 36 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

6
7 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
8 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
9 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
10 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
11 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
12 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
13 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
14 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15
16 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
18 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
21 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
22 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
23 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
24 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
25 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
26 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
