21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the Arkansas Governor's Mansion Commission for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the
25 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
26 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
27 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
28 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
29 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
30 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
31 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
32 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
33 101), or its successor.

11 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the
 12 Arkansas Governor's Mansion Commission for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the
 13 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as
 14 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: four
 15 (4) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to
 16 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or
 17 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

19 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 20 the Arkansas Governor's Mansion Commission, to be payable from the State
 21 Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 22 Arkansas Governor's Mansion Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30,
 23 2010, the following:

35 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas
 36 Governor's Mansion Commission, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in

1 the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
2 for expenses of the Arkansas Governor’s Mansion, Grand Hall and grounds of
3 the Arkansas Governor’s Mansion Commission for the fiscal year ending June
4 30, 2010, the following:

10 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
12 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
13 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Agency is
14 authorized to transfer appropriation from line items (01) and (03) authorized
15 in Section 3 Appropriation - Operations of this Act to the Mansion Expense
16 line item authorized in Section 3.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
18 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

20 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
21 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
22 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
23 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

29
30 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
31 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
32 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
33 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
34 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
35 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
36 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

1 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

2
3 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
4 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
5 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
6 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
7 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
9 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
10 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
11 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
12 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
13 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
