## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO HEALTH BENEFITS FOR MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS WHO HAVE RETIRED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO HEALTH BENEFITS FOR MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS WHO HAVE RETIRED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 24, Chapter 10, Subchapter 6 is amended to add a new section to read as follows:

24-10-620. Health benefits for retired police officers.
(a) A retired police officer may participate in the health care plan of the municipality from which he or she retired if he or she:
(1) Is receiving a retirement benefit from the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System, Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System, or a local police pension fund;
(2) Is eligible for Medicare; and
(3) Pays both the employer and the employee contribution to the health care plan.
(b) A retired police officer who participates in a municipality's health care plan under subsection (a) of this section:
(1) May include his or her dependents in the retiree's health care plan if the retired police officer pays both the employer and employee contribution to the health care plan for his or her dependents; and
