20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-55-504 is amended to read as follows:
23 14-55-504. Maximum penalties permitted.

24 (a)(1) ~~Municipal~~ Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section,
25 municipal corporations shall not have power to inflict any fine or penalty,
26 by ordinance or otherwise, to a greater sum than five hundred dollars (\$500)
27 for any one (1) specified offense or violation of a bylaw or ordinance, or
28 double that sum for each repetition of such offense or violation.

29 (2) If a thing prohibited or rendered unlawful is, in its
30 nature, continuous in respect to time, the fine or penalty for allowing the
31 continuance thereof, in violation of the bylaw or ordinance, shall not exceed
32 two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for each day that it may be unlawfully
33 continued.

34 (b) If any bylaw or ordinance provides for any greater fine, penalty,
35 or forfeiture than is provided in this section, it shall and may be lawful,
36 in any suit or prosecution for the recovery thereof, to reduce it to such



1 amount as shall be deemed reasonable and proper and to permit a recovery or
2 render a judgment for such amount as authorized.

3 (c) For a violation of an ordinance regulating or forbidding the
4 unsafe discharge of a firearm, a city of the first class may impose penalties
5 consistent with an unclassified misdemeanor under § 5-1-107, including
6 incarceration not exceeding ninety (90) days or a fine not exceeding ten
7 thousand dollars (\$10,000), or both.
