3	critical teacher shortage area with a higher education institution is exempt
4	from this section and shall be employed with no limitations placed on his or
5	her earnings.
6	(2)(A) The Department of Higher Education shall establish a list
7	of critical teacher shortage areas each school year.
8	(B) For purposes of this subdivision, "critical teacher
9	shortage area" means a lack of certified teachers in a particular subject
10	area or in a geographic location as determined annually by the Director of
11	the Department of Higher Education.
12	(3) For a retired member returning to work under subdivision
13	(h)(l) of this section, the employer and employee contribution rate to the
14	system on behalf of the retired member shall recommence at the rate in effect
15	at the time of the employment and shall be remitted by the employer.
