28 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as 29 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions: 30 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 2010 the Agency shall by written statement set 31 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or 32 funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget; 33 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall 34 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from 35 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the 36 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget

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1 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year <del>of the biennial period</del> which 2 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution 3 and the amount of the <del>appropriation and/or</del> funding carried forward from the 4 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item, 5 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request 6 set forth in (1) above;

7 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written 8 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 9 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written 10 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for 11 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 12 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 13 14 Committee; and

15 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include 16 all information obtained in item (3) above in the <del>biennial</del> budget manuals 17 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or 18 Institution.

20 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 22 CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION. Expenditures shall not be made from the Marketing 23 and Redistribution Special Maintenance Commitment Item unless approved by the 24 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Special Maintenance Expenditures may 25 include repairs, equipment and expenses related to Infrastructure.

26The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,2720072009through June 30, 20092010

SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SELECTION OF AUDITOR. The Legislative Auditor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall jointly select the independent auditor to audit the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for the <del>biennial</del> period ending June 30, <u>2009</u> <u>2011</u>. 34

35 SECTION 27. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 36 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

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made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9 SECTION 28. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 10 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

18 SECTION 29. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 20 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the 24 25 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009. 29 30 31 32 33 34
