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2	SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - CAPITAL OUTLAY/OPERATING EXPENSES. There is
3	hereby appropriated, to the Land Department, to be payable from cash funds as
4	defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Land Department, from proceeds of
5	fees collected by the Land Department, for operating expenses and capital
6	outlay of the Land Department for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the

13	SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code §19-6-301(103), concerning
14	fees for the removal of minerals or timber from state land, is repealed.
15	(103) Fees charged by the Department of Finance and Administration for
16	removal of minerals or timber from state land as authorized by Acts 1975, No.
17	524, § 4, as amended, § 22-5-808, but excluding the five dollars (\$5.00)
18	declared to be cash funds to be deposited into the Revenue Department
19	Building Fund in accordance with Acts 1961 (1st Ex. Sess.), No. 38;

21	SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. <u>Arkansas Code § 19-6-428 is repealed.</u>
22	19-6-428. Severed Resources Fund.
23	The Severed Resources Fund shall consist of those special revenues as
24	specified in § 19-6-301(103), there to be used in exercising the powers,
25	functions, and duties as set out in § 22-5-801 et seq., or its successor.
26	
27	SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. <u>Arkansas Code §22-5-808</u> , concerning Leases
28	and Permits - Records - Fees - Disposition of Funds, is amended to read as
29	follows:
30	(a) The office of the Commissioner of State Lands shall maintain a permanent
31	record of all leases and permits issued under this section and $\$ 22-5-801 $-$
32	22-5-807 and 22-5-809 - 22-5-813.
33	(b) (1) The person, firm, company, corporation, or association making
34	application or filing a competitive bid for a lease or permit with the State
35	of Arkansas shall pay a fee to cover the cost of processing its application.
36	(2) The amount of the fee shall be set by the Commissioner of State

- 1 Lands and shall be deposited in the State Treasury as each funds and credited
- 2 to the Severed Resources Fund as cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code §19-
- 3 4-801.
- 4 (c) (1)—The funds shall be used to pay for the advertising, processing,
- 5 and recording of applications received.
- 6 (2) Fund balances in the Severed Resources Fund in excess of five
- 7 thousand dollars (\$5,000) on June 30 of each year shall be transferred and
- 8 credited to the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund no later than the
- 9 August 15 following.

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- 11 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 12 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 13 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 14 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 18 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 21 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 23 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 28 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 30 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 32 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
- 33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
- 34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 35 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 36 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the

1	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
2	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
3	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
4	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
