12	(a) Upon conviction, any person driving a motor vehicle or motor	
13	bicycle upon a public highway in this state in a race shall be punished as	
14	prescribed in § 27-50-302.	
15	(b)(1) It is unlawful and considered an additional offense for a	
16	person to use nitrous oxide in a race on a public street or highway in this	
17	state as prohibited under § 27-37-803.	
18	(2) A person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or is found	
19	guilty of a violation under subdivision (b)(1) of this section shall be	
20	punished as prescribed under § 27-50-302.	
21	(a) As used in this section:	
22	(1) "Drag race" means:	
23	(A) The operation of two (2) or more motor vehicles from a	
24	point side-by-side at accelerating speeds in a competitive attempt to	
25	outdistance each other;	
26	(B) The operation of one (1) or more motor vehicles over a	
27	common selected course, from the same point to the same point, for the	
28	purpose of comparing the relative speeds or power of acceleration of the	
29	motor vehicle or motor vehicles within a certain distance or time limit; and	
30	(2) "Race" means the operation or use of one (1) or more motor	
31	vehicles in an attempt to:	
32	(A) Outgain or outdistance another motor vehicle;

1	(b)(l) A person commits the crime of racing if he or she knowingly:

6	(C) Rides as a passenger in or on a motor vehicle in any

9	(c)(1) A person commits the crime of observing a drag race as a
10	spectator on a public highway if he or she:
11	(A) Knowingly is present at and observes a drag race; and
12	(B) Is present as the result of an affirmative choice to
13	attend or participate in the drag race.
14	(2) Observing a drag race is a Class B misdemeanor.
