25	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determine	ned by the General		
26	Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for	r the operations of		
27	the Department of Finance and Administration - Managemen	t Services Division		
28	are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of			
29	Finance and Administration - Management Services Division to continue to			
30	provide essential governmental services; that the provis	ions of this act will		
31	provide the necessary monies for the Department of Finance	ce and Administration		
32	- Management Services Division to continue such services; and that a delay in			
33	the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper			
34	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,			
35	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the			
36	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and sa	afety shall be in		

1	full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
2	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
3	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
4	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
5	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
6	the veto.
