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21	SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIA	ATION - STATE PARKS - FEDERAL. T	here is hereby
22	appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the		
23	federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the		
24	Department of Parks and Tourism, the following:		
25	(A) Effective July 1,	2009, the balance of the appro	priation provided in
26	Item (A) of Section 2 of	Act 1141 of 2007, for funding t	o begin construction
27	of facilities planned to	support the establishment of th	e Mississippi River
28	State Park, in a sum not	to exceed	\$280,800.
29	(B) Effective July 1,	2009, the balance of the appro	priation provided in
30	Item (B) of Section 2 of	Act 1141 of 2007, for funding t	o design, construct,
31	repair and renovate Airport Infrastructure at the Petit Jean State Park		
32	Airport, in a sum not to	exceed	\$706,448.

There is 21 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable 22 from the Department of Parks and Tourism Fund Account, for the Department of 23 Parks and Tourism, the following: 24 (A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in 25 Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 446 of 2007 and Item (5) of Section 6 of Act 26 1227 of 2007, for construction projects at various parks system-wide, in a 27 sum not to exceed\$13,324,166. 28 29 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - CONSERVATION TAX - CONSTRUCTION. There is 30 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the Department of Parks and Tourism Fund Account, for the Department of 31 32 Parks and Tourism, the following: 33 (A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in 34 Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 446 of 2007 of Item (5) of Section 6 of Act 1227 of 2007, for construction projects at various parks system-wide, in a sum not 35 to exceed\$11,159,288. 36

8	1227 of 2007, for special maintenance projects at various parks system-wide,		
9	in a sum not to exceed\$1,425,936.		
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11	SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - U.S. MARSHAL MUSEUM. There is hereby		
12	appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the		
13	General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the		
14	Department of Parks and Tourism, the following:		
15	(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in		
16	Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 893 of 2007, for planning, construction, and		
17	development of a National U.S. Marshal Museum in Fort Smith, Arkansas, in a		
18	sum not to exceed\$22,800,000.		
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20	SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS AND CONSTRUCTION - CASH FUNDS.		
21	There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be		
22	payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by		
23	the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Parks and		
24	Tourism, the following:		
25	(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in		
26	Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 446 of 2007, for construction, in a sum not to		
27	exceed\$132,842.

29	SECTION 9. REAPPROPRIATION - NATURAL RESOURCES MUSEUM GRANT. There is		
30	hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable		
31	from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for		
32	the Department of Parks and Tourism, the following:		
33	(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in		
34	Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 1697 of 2007, for a grant to natural resources		
35	museums in Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$20,000.		

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1 SECTION 10. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE PARK IMPROVEMENTS. There is 2 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for 3 4 the Department of Parks and Tourism, the following: 5 (A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in 6 Item (1) of Section 30 of Act 793 of 2007, for extra help for construction of the Cossatot River Trail Corridor, in a sum not to exceed\$38,401. 7 8 (B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in 9 Item (1) of Section 30 of Act 793 of 2007, for payroll matching for the Cossatot River Trail Corridor project, in a sum not to exceed\$10,430. 10 11 (C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (1) of Section 30 of Act 793 of 2007, for construction for 21 state park 12 projects in various stages of design, construction, renovation and land 13 14 15 16 SECTION 11. REAPPROPRIATION - ATTRACTING RETIREES. There is hereby 17 appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the 18 19 Department of Parks and Tourism, the following: (A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in 20 21 Section 24 of Act 1227 of 2007, for the purpose of attracting retirees to the 22 State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000. 23 24 SECTION 12. REAPPROPRIATION - AMPHITHEATER. There is hereby appropriated, 25 to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the General 26 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department 27 of Parks and Tourism, the following: 28 (A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in 29 Item (A) of Section 27 of Act 1227 of 2007, for the constructing and 30 equipping of an Amphitheater, in a sum not to exceed\$125,000. 31 32 SECTION 13. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 33 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 34 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 35 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and

agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and

- 1 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
- 2 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
- 3 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
- 4 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
- 5 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
- 6 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
- 7 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
- 8 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
- 9 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
- 10 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
- 11 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
- 12 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
- 13 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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- 15 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 16 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 17 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 18 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 19 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 20 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 21 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 22 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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- 24 SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 26 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
- 27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
- 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 29 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 30 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
- 31 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
- 32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
- 33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
- 34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.

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
