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1 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective 2 date of this act, the Chief Fiscal officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State 3 4 the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) from the General Revenue 5 Allotment Reserve Fund to the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account to provide 6 funds for the appropriation provided herein. 7 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 8 9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 17 18 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 26 27 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 28 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 29 the Department of Information Systems are, due to unforeseen circumstances, 30 insufficient for the Department of Information Systems to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide 31 32 the necessary monies for the Department of Information Systems to continue 33 such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work 34 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential 35 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 36
