5 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>FUNDING</u> 7 <u>TRANSFER.</u> Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal 8 Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the 9 <u>State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of two hundred thirty-</u> 10 <u>seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$237,500) from the General Revenue</u> 11 <u>Allotment Reserve Fund to the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account to provide</u>

12 <u>funds for the appropriation provided herein.</u>

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 14 15 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 16 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 17 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 20 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 24 25 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 26 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 27 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 28 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 30 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 31 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

33 <u>SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the General

34 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of

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35 the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management are, due to unforeseen

36 <u>circumstances</u>, insufficient for the Arkansas Department of Emergency

1	Management to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
2	provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas
3	Department of Emergency Management to continue such services; and that a
4	delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the
5	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
6	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
7	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
8	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
9	passage and approval.
10	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
11	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
12	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
13	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
14	the veto.
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
