33 SECTION 42. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LANDFILL
 35 POST-CLOSURE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Any expenditures in excess of \$50,000
 36 per site from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund, as appropriated in

Section 20, Item (04) for corrective action to remedy environmental impacts of closed disposal sites previously operated as a landfill pursuant to state law will be prioritized and authorized by the Commission after addressing corrective actions needed to address environmental impacts from permitted landfills closed properly. The total of the said expenditures for the biennium shall not exceed five percent (5%) of the fund balance as of July 1, 2007 2009.

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9 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 10 NON 11 HAZARDOUS SITE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Expenditures from the Arkansas 12 Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund for the clean up of non 13 hazardous sites which pose a threat to the environment, as appropriated in 14 Section 33, shall be funded only through interest earnings from the Arkansas 15 Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund. The Arkansas Department 16 of Environmental Quality shall seek cost recovery from parties responsible 17 for damages to the environment that dictate the use of appropriation 18 authorized in Section 33 of this act, as well as, any other funds spent by a 19 governmental entity to remediate such non hazardous sites. 20

SECTION 44. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 21 22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 24 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

31 SECTION 45. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. SECTION 46. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
