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32 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the 33 Office of the Treasurer of State for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following 34 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra 35 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: ten (10) 36 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed

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those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

4 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to 5 the Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the State Central 6 Services Fund, for personal services, operating expenses, data processing 7 system/services and debt collection of the Office of the Treasurer of State 8 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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25 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 26 FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 2010, any 27 28 unexpended appropriation and funds provided for the Data Processing 29 System/Services line item shall be carried forward and made available for the 30 same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 2011. Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as 31 32 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions: 33 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 2010 the Agency shall by written statement set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or 34 35 funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget; (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall 36

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report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from 1 2 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 3 4 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which 5 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution 6 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the 7 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item, 8 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request 9 set forth in (1) above;

10 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written 11 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 12 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for 13 14 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 15 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents 16 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 17 Committee; and

18 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include 19 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals 20 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or 21 Institution.

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23 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 25 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 26 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Treasurer of 27 State is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item authorized 28 in Section 3 Appropriation - Operations of the Treasurer's Office in this Act 29 to any other line item authorized in Section 3.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
31 2007 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

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33 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 34 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 35 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 36 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 3 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 8 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 9 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 10 11 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 12 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 13 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 14 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 18 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of 19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 20 21 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 22 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the 23 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 24 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 25 26 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009. 27 28 */s/ Joint Budget Committee* 29
