22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 27, is amended to add the
25 following section, to read as follows:

26 12-27-132. Award of pistol upon retirement.

27 When a Department of Community Correction parole or probation officer
28 retires from service or dies while still employed with the department, in
29 recognition of and appreciation for the service of the retiring or deceased
30 parole or probation officer the department may award the pistol carried by
31 the officer at the time of his or her death or retirement from service to:

32 (1) The parole or probation officer; or

33 (2) The parole or probation officer's spouse if the spouse is
34 eligible under applicable state and federal laws to possess a firearm.
