- 29 of general fumigation shall furnish the board a certificate of insurance
- 30 written by an insurance company authorized to do business in this state
- 31 covering the public liability of the applicant for personal injuries for not
- 32 less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for any one (1) person, and
- 33 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for any one (1) accident, and not less than
- 34 five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for property damage.
- 35 (2) In addition to the bond required in subdivision (a)(1) of
- 36 this section, before a license is issued or renewed, each applicant for a

1	license or any combination of licenses that includes the classification of		
2	termite and other structural pests shall furnish the board a certificate of		
3	insurance for a general liability insurance policy written by an insurance		
4	company authorized to do business in this state covering public liability of		
5	the applicant for personal injuries and property damage in an amount not less		
6	than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) per occurrence or five hundred		
7	thousand dollars (\$500,000) per aggregate.		
8	(c) Cancellation.		
9	(1) The bond and insurance shall not be cancelled or terminated		
10	until at least thirty (30) days after a notice of cancellation is received by		
11	the board.		
12	(2) Upon failure of a licensee to maintain in full force and		
13	effect the bond and insurance required by this section, the license shall		
14	become void and shall not be reinstated until a satisfactory bond and		
15	insurance have been filed.		
16			
17	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
18	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the surety bond and insurance		
19	requirements for pest control licensees dealing with hazardous chemicals are		
20	necessary to insure the public health and safety; and that it is imperative		
21	that these new requirements coincide with the start of the next fiscal year.		
22	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately		
23	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
24	become effective on July 1, 2009.
