25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-61-111(a)(1), regarding the ordering of
28 militia into service, is amended to read as follows:

29 (a)(1) The Governor shall have power to order into the active service
30 of the state for such a period, to such extent, and in such manner as he may
31 deem necessary, all or any part of the organized militia:

32 (A) ~~in~~ In case of invasion, disaster, insurrection, riot,
33 breach of the peace, or imminent danger thereof; ~~or~~

34 (B) ~~to~~ To preserve the public health and security and
35 maintain law and order; or

36 (C) For the purpose of working with other state agencies



1 in the planning and training for emergencies or disasters and to respond to
2 emergencies or disasters to order into the active service of the state for
3 such a period, to such extent, and in such manner as he may deem necessary,
4 all or any part of the organized militia.
