- 35 PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized,

1 request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds 2 Transfer" to the Maintenance and General Operations classifications established in the operations appropriation of the Department of Arkansas 3 4 State Police, and may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated 5 taxes and/or motor vehicle equipping/renovation costs, agency operational 6 needs and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police. 7 Fund transfers may be requested from the Court Awards Fund to the Department 8 of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as 9 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section. 10 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval 11 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 12 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 13 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 14 15 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 16 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 17 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more 18 19 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas 20 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. MOTOR VEHICLE ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND - MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At least fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues and/or general improvement funds deposited into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be used for motor vehicle purchases and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for

- 1 the Department of Arkansas State Police.
- 2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 3 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

- 5 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.
- 7 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime
- 8 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to

- 11 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable

2	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations

5	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
6	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8	SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
9	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
10	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
11	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
12	the agency for which the appropriations in this \mbox{Act} are provided, and that in
13	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
14	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
15	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
16	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

18	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
