16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
17 STATE POLICE APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
18 2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
25 Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the  
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be  
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions  
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
34 101), or its successor.

27 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby  
28 authorized to purchase from Maintenance & General Operations Classifications  
29 in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to  
30 exceed \$2,500 each fiscal year, promotional items, authorized by the Director  
31 of the Department to meet requirements of the Arkansas State Police Strategic  
32 Recruitment Plan.

36 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COURT  
2 AWARDS FUND TRANSFER PROVISION. Monies deposited in the Court Awards Fund  
3 each fiscal year may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes  
4 and/or motor vehicle equipping and renovation costs, agency operational needs  
5 and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police.  
6 Provided however, funds received from the Special State Assets Forfeiture  
7 Fund shall be deposited into the Court Awards Fund to be used by the  
8 Department of Arkansas State Police for law enforcement purposes consistent  
9 with governing federal law. The Department of Arkansas State Police may also  
10 request a fund transfer from the Court Awards Fund or the Arkansas State  
11 Police Fund to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund. The provisions  
12 of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas  
13 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

14 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
15 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year  
16 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by  
17 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and  
18 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by  
19 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly  
20 has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more  
21 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas  
22 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is  
23 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight  
24 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget

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33 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
35 PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized,  
36 after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to

1 request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds  
2 Transfer" to the Maintenance and General Operations classifications  
3 established in the operations appropriation of the Department of Arkansas  
4 State Police, and may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated  
5 taxes and/or motor vehicle equipping/renovation costs, agency operational  
6 needs and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police.  
7 Fund transfers may be requested from the Court Awards Fund to the Department  
8 of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as  
9 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section.  
10 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval  
11 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

12 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
13 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year  
14 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by  
15 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and  
16 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by

33 VEHICLE ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND – MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At  
34 least fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues and/or general improvement  
35 funds deposited into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be  
36 used for motor vehicle purchases and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for

1 the Department of Arkansas State Police.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~  
3 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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5 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.  
7 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime  
8 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to  
9 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be  
10 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to  
11 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable  
12 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the  
13 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime  
14 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be  
15 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~  
17 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

18  
19 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR  
21 VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby  
22 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for  
23 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act.  
24 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles used  
25 for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the maximum  
26 number of authorized passenger vehicles.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~  
28 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

29  
30 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM  
32 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas  
33 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer  
34 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
35 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee  
36 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the

1 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims  
2 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined  
3 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance  
4 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the  
5 department, the ~~86th~~ 87th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and  
6 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide  
7 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public  
8 employees insurance program.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~  
10 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

11  
12 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

14 EXTRAORDINARY EXPENSES. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby  
15 authorized to purchase from Maintenance & Operations Classifications in the  
16 Operations Appropriation provided by in this Act, up to an amount not to  
17 exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) each fiscal year, for  
18 emergency purchases for food, drinks and other essential items during  
19 emergency operations only when authorized by the Agency Director. During an  
20 emergency, an ASP employee may be designated and authorized, by the Director,  
21 to incur expenses for all deployed personnel.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2009  
23 through June 30, 2010.

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25 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

1 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
2 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
3 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
5 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
6 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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8 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
9 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
10 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
11 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of  
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
13 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
14 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the  
15 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
16 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
17 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
18 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
