## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS WITH RESPECT TO THE ISSUANCE OF A TEMPORARY ELECTRICIAN'S LICENSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-28-301(d), concerning the issuance of a temporary license for a master electrician or journeyman electrician, is amended to read as follows:
(d) The board shall be is authorized to issue a temporary license as a master electrician or journeyman electrician that shall be is valid for no more than six (6) months and be renewable one (l) time only for industry projects as defined in this chapter, upon submission by the applicant of the following:
(1) A temporary license fee in the amount established by subsection (a) of this section;
(2) A completed application on a form furnished and approved by the board; and
(3) Evidence that the applicant:
(A) holds Holds a current license of the same

classification issued by another state; or
(B) has otherwise met Meets the experience
qualifications required under this chapter for the type of license being applied for rules promulgated by the board for a temporary master electrician or a temporary journeyman electrician.
