1	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
2	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that institutions of higher		
3	education may receive additional revenue from sources other than general		
4	revenue; that revisions to the number of provisional positions may be		
5	necessary to serve the students enrolled for the 2009-2010 and 2010-2011		
6	academic years; that expedited implementation of this act is necessary so		
7	that the affected institutions of higher education can properly prepare for		
8	the upcoming academic year; that the failure to implement this act by July 1,		
9	2009, will cause irreparable harm to the education of the students enrolled		
10	for the 2009-2010 academic year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
11	exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace,		
12	health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2009.
