8 CONTRIBUTIONS. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration  
9 is authorized to transfer Appropriation and Funding between State's  
10 Contributions line items authorized in Section 1. Any unexpended balances in  
11 ~~appropriation and~~ funds provided for State's Contributions in this Act  
12 remaining June 30, ~~2008~~ 2009, shall be carried forward during the fiscal year  
13 ending June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

14

15 SECTION 86. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
17 PROCEDURES - PER DIEM MATCHING. If there is not sufficient appropriation,  
18 from funds deposited in the State Treasury or Cash Accounts of an agency, for  
19 personal services, or personal services matching for any state agency for the  
20 ~~biennial~~ period ending June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010, for State agencies that process  
21 payroll through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for  
22 federal and state tax reporting as necessary to comply with the payment of  
23 stipends under United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec  
24 3401 and Treasury Regulations §31.3401(c)-1(a) and §1.1402(c)-2(b), and  
25 others which govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and  
26 matching taxes for personal services, the agency shall request a transfer  
27 from appropriation provided for Personal Services and Personal Services  
28 Matching in the appropriation for Various State Agencies - U.S. IRC and  
29 Treasury Regulations herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,  
30 stating clearly the amounts required for each item. Upon approval of the  
31 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Auditor shall be notified as to  
32 the amount and the purposes for which the appropriation is to be made and  
33 such appropriation as needed shall be established upon the books of the  
34 Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided,  
35 however, that in the event the total amount of transfer requested in any  
36 fiscal year exceeds Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), the Chief Fiscal Officer

1 of the State shall seek prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
2 Joint Budget Committee before the transfer shall be made.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~  
4 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

5  
6 SECTION 87. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSITION  
8 ESTABLISHMENT. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall have the authority  
9 to establish such positions as necessary for State agencies to process  
10 payroll through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for  
11 federal and state tax reporting purposes as necessary to comply with the  
12 United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec 3401 and  
13 Treasury Regulations §31.3401(c)-1(a) and §1.1402(c)-2(b), and others which  
14 govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and matching taxes  
15 for personal services. The positions established shall not be considered as  
16 part of the total number of authorized positions for an agency and shall only  
17 be considered as placeholders for payments to individuals who are board or  
18 commission members or elected officials of the State that do not otherwise  
19 receive salaries or wages as defined in §19-4-521 for their personal  
20 services. Further, none of the positions established under this section  
21 shall imply eligibility for state retirement or state health insurance  
22 benefits. The establishment of such positions shall not exceed 250 positions  
23 in any fiscal year.

24  
25 SECTION 88. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
27 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal  
28 Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the  
29 State Treasurer and Auditor of State the sum of two million dollars  
30 (\$2,000,000) from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund to the Executive  
31 Discretionary Division of the 87<sup>th</sup> Session Projects Account of the General  
32 Improvement Fund to assist in funding authorizations for the Arkansas Delta  
33 Training and Education Consortium (ADTEC).

34  
35 SECTION 89. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER

1 AUTHORIZED. The Arkansas Children's Hospital may request the Chief Fiscal  
2 Officer of the State to transfer the sum of not to exceed \$1,000,000 each  
3 fiscal year from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account from funds made  
4 available by this Act for the Arkansas Children's Hospital Burn Center to the  
5 Department of Human Service Grants Fund Account. The transferred funds shall  
6 be used to match federal funds used for supplemental Medicaid payments to  
7 Arkansas Children's Hospital.

8  
9 SECTION 90. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
11 INNOVATION AND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT FUND TRANSFERS. The Department of  
12 Information Systems is a cost recovery agency subject to the requirements of  
13 the United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87 Cost  
14 Principles for State, Local and Indian Tribal Government (A-87) and Cost  
15 Principles for Developing Cost Allocation Plans and Indirect Cost Rates for  
16 Agreements with the Federal Government Implementation Guide for the Office of  
17 Management and Budget Circular A-87 (ASMBC-10). To comply with these federal  
18 rules, it is necessary to establish an Innovation and Project Development  
19 appropriation and general revenue fund account within the Department of  
20 Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer for the Department of  
21 Information Systems. This fund shall be used for state enterprise innovation  
22 projects that would enhance the technology operations of the Sate that cannot  
23 be cost allocated to federal programs. The Department of Information Systems  
24 will maintain documentation for projects billed for these purposes. Fund  
25 transfers may be made from the General Revenue Fund Account, upon the  
26 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review of the  
27 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to reimburse the  
28 Department of Information Systems for the amounts billed.

29  
30 SECTION 91. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK  
32 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the  
33 various technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have  
34 been determined as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2), such documents  
35 as may be necessary shall be processed so that funds may be transferred from  
36 the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the State Treasury fund or fund

1 account from which the technical institute or comprehensive lifelong learning  
2 center draws its general revenue support. Such funds as may be transferred  
3 shall not exceed 6.309% of the total funds available from the Work Force 2000  
4 Development Fund during each fiscal year ~~of the biennial period ending June~~  
5 ~~30, 2009~~.

6 In the event that a technical college, community college or educational  
7 institution which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund  
8 as determined by law transfers from the Arkansas Technical College and  
9 Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies  
10 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force  
11 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational  
12 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of  
13 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~  
15 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

16  
17 SECTION 92. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
18 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
19 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
20 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

26  
27 SECTION 93. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
30 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
32 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
33 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
34 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

35  
36 SECTION 94. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

1 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
2 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
3 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of  
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the  
5 exception that the appropriation section in this Act regarding the Governor's  
6 Emergency Proclamation shall be in full force and effect from and after the  
7 date of its passage and approval, and that in the event of an extension of  
8 the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July  
9 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and  
10 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is  
11 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate  
12 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force  
13 and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
