1 (7) Perform all other powers and functions necessary to fulfill its 2 duties. 3 (c) The Commission shall be subject to audit by the Division of Legislative 4 Audit. 5 6 SECTION 85. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. STATE'S 8 CONTRIBUTIONS. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration 9 is authorized to transfer Appropriation and Funding between State's 10 Contributions line items authorized in Section 1. Any unexpended balances in 11 appropriation and funds provided for State's Contributions in this Act remaining June 30, 2008 2009, shall be carried forward during the fiscal year 12 13 ending June 30, 2009 2010. 14 15 SECTION 86. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 17 PROCEDURES - PER DIEM MATCHING. If there is not sufficient appropriation, from funds deposited in the State Treasury or Cash Accounts of an agency, for 18 19 personal services, or personal services matching for any state agency for the 20 biennial period ending June 30, 2009 2010, for State agencies that process 21 payroll through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for 22 federal and state tax reporting as necessary to comply with the payment of stipends under United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec 23 24 3401 and Treasury Regulations 31.3401(c)-1(a) and 1.1402(c)-2(b), and others which govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and 25 26 matching taxes for personal services, the agency shall request a transfer 27 from appropriation provided for Personal Services and Personal Services 28 Matching in the appropriation for Various State Agencies - U.S. IRC and 29 Treasury Regulations herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, 30 stating clearly the amounts required for each item. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Auditor shall be notified as to 31 32 the amount and the purposes for which the appropriation is to be made and 33 such appropriation as needed shall be established upon the books of the 34 Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided,

however, that in the event the total amount of transfer requested in any

fiscal year exceeds Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), the Chief Fiscal Officer

Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal 28 Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and Auditor of State the sum of two million dollars 29 30 (\$2,000,000) from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund to the Executive Discretionary Division of the 87<sup>th</sup> Session Projects Account of the General 31 32 Improvement Fund to assist in funding authorizations for the Arkansas Delta

35 SECTION 89. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER

Training and Education Consortium (ADTEC).

- 1 AUTHORIZED. The Arkansas Children's Hospital may request the Chief Fiscal
- 2 Officer of the State to transfer the sum of not to exceed \$1,000,000 each
- 3 fiscal year from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account from funds made

- 21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

SECTION 94. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

1	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
2	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
3	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
4	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the
5	exception that the appropriation section in this Act regarding the Governor's
6	Emergency Proclamation shall be in full force and effect from and after the
7	date of its passage and approval, and that in the event of an extension of
8	the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July
9	1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
10	provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
11	hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
12	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force
13	and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
