SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code §6-17-1117(b)(1), concerning contributions to health insurance premiums of public school employees, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1)(A) The Department of Education shall pay the Employee Benefits
Division of the Department of Finance and Administration a minimum of sixtyone dollars (\$61.00) per month for each eligible employee electing to
participate in the public school employees' health insurance program
administered by the State and Public School Life and Health Insurance Board.

19 (B) The Department of Education shall make the total contributions 20 under subdivision (b)(1)(A) of this section by transferring thirty-five 21 million dollars (\$35,000,000) to the division in eleven (11) equal monthly 22 installments the full amount of appropriation and funding available for the 23 purpose of this subdivision (b)(1).

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25 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 31 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

2	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
