22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Community Correction for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
34 101), or its successor.

23 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY

25 CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. After seeking and receiving approval of

26 the Governor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and upon approval by the

27 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the

28 Department of Community Correction, as authorized by the Board of

29 Corrections, is authorized to use funds appropriated for "Community

30 Correction Programs" line item in this Act to construct new or renovate

31 existing facilities to support the development of community correction

32 facilities in the state.

33 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of

34 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year

35 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by

36 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
 2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
 3 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more
 4 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community

 3 authorized in Section 3 and Section 4 of this Act to any other line item

 26 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the Board of Corrections
 27 that a reallocation of resources within the Department of Community
 28 Correction and Department of Correction is necessary for the efficient and
 29 effective operation of the departments, the Board, with approval of the
 30 Governor and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 31 Committee, shall have the authority to instruct the department directors, to
 32 request from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a transfer of positions,
 33 programs, funds, appropriations, and line-item appropriations within or
 34 between existing and newly created divisions, offices, sections, or units of
 35 the departments. If it is determined that the requested transfer should be
 36 made, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then initiate the necessary

1 transfer documents to reflect the transfers upon the fiscal records of the
 2 State Treasurer, the State Auditor, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
 3 and the Departments of Correction and Community Correction. Provided,
 4 however, that the Board shall be limited to submitting no more than ~~four~~ one
 5 requests, encompassing a single purpose listed in this section, ~~for~~
 6 ~~Reallocation of Resources Transfer requests~~ during any fiscal year per
 7 department. Transfer authority shall further be limited to no more than five
 8 percent (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation,
 9 funding, and positions specific to each agency. However, there shall be no
 10 transfers to or from the County Jail Reimbursement Fund. A Reallocation of
 11 Resources Transfer shall be limited to the following specific purposes:

- 12 a) Costs to open and operate temporary beds;
- 13 b) Payment of Debt Service;
- 14 c) Payment of Overtime Expenses;
- 15 d) Unanticipated increases for medical or private prison contracts;
- 16 e) Construction/renovation/equipping of new beds;
- 17 f) Deficits in Farm or Industry Program;
- 18 g) Losses not covered by insurance proceeds;
- 19 h) Costs of personnel for critical services or necessary to carry out the
 20 mission of the agency.

21 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
 22 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
 23 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
 24 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
 25 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
 26 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
 27 has determined that the Department of Correction and the Department of
 28 Community Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is
 29 provided to the Board of Corrections authorizing broad powers under the
 30 Reallocation of Resources provisions herein. Therefore, it is both necessary
 31 and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring
 32 prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as
 33 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
 34 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
 35 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 36 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court jurisdiction, this entire

1 section is void.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

5 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HOLIDAY
7 COMPENSATION. The Department of Community Correction is authorized to pay
8 employees for up to ninety-six (96) hours of unused holidays exceeding a
9 balance in the employee's holiday account of one-hundred fifty (150) hours
10 following the end of the calendar year. Payments of unused holiday hours must
11 be processed on or before June 1st in each fiscal year. Employees terminating
12 employment from the Department of Community Correction will be eligible for
13 all holiday pay accrued during the years of service. This request is
14 contingent on approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State after the
15 Director of the Department of Community Correction has verified that
16 sufficient revenues are available to make such payments to employees in the
17 following classifications:

32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MEDICAL
33 SERVICES - CONTINGENCY POSITIONS. If it has been determined by the Board of
34 Corrections that the Department of Community Correction cannot continue a
35 medical contract with a private provider and the Board deems it necessary to
36 utilize Department staff to provide the required services, the Department is

1 allowed, upon notification of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after
 2 seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 3 Committee, to utilize the contingent positions for medical services contained
 4 in this Act and make the appropriate transfers from the Professional Fees and
 5 Services line item contained in Section 3 of this Act to Regular Salaries,
 6 Personal Services Matching and various Maintenance and General Operations
 7 classifications. Further, the Department may utilize the service(s) of a
 8 state-based or national-based Professional Recruitment Service, or network,
 9 as may be necessary to recruit, fill, or maintain the occupancy of the
 10 positions stated herein.

 14 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

 16 SALARIES - CONTINGENT POSITIONS. There is hereby established for the

 21 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
 22 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
 23 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
 24 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
 25 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
 26 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code 21-5-101), or its successor.

1 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
 2 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
 3 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
 4 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
 5 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
 6 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more
 7 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
 8 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
 9 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
 10 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 11 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
 12 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
 13 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
 14 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
 15 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

17 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
 19 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Departments of Correction and Community
 20 Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare and post
 21 on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail
 22 reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for
 23 verification by the Departments and for payment from the County Jail
 24 Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of
 25 invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the
 26 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end
 27 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than
 28 three (3) years.

30 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 31 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 33 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

3
4 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

13 SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
