13	CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. The appropriations authorized under the

27	AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent
28	(10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of Community

1 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 2 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 3 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 4 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 5 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 6 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more 7 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community 8 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 9 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 10 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 11 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 12 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 13 14 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 15 jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 16 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY 18 19 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Departments of Correction and Community 20 Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare and post 21 on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail 22 reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for 23 verification by the Departments and for payment from the County Jail 24 Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of 25 invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the 26 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end 27 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than 28 three (3) years. 29 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. 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4	SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
5	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
11	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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13	SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
16	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
17	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
20	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
