22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Community Correction for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
34 101), or its successor.

36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY

1 CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. After seeking and receiving approval of
2 the Governor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and upon approval by the
3 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the
4 Department of Community Correction, as authorized by the Board of
5 Corrections, is authorized to use funds appropriated for "Community
6 Correction Programs" line item in this Act to construct new or renovate
7 existing facilities to support the development of community correction
8 facilities in the state.

9 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
10 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
11 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
12 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
13 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
14 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
15 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more
16 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
17 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both

2 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the Board of Corrections
3 that a reallocation of resources within the Department of Community
4 Correction and Department of Correction is necessary for the efficient and
5 effective operation of the departments, the Board, with approval of the
6 Governor and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
7 Committee, shall have the authority to instruct the department directors, to
8 request from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a transfer of positions,
9 programs, funds, appropriations, and line-item appropriations within or
10 between existing and newly created divisions, offices, sections, or units of
11 the departments. If it is determined that the requested transfer should be
12 made, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then initiate the necessary
13 transfer documents to reflect the transfers upon the fiscal records of the
14 State Treasurer, the State Auditor, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
15 and the Departments of Correction and Community Correction. Provided,
16 however, that the Board shall be limited to submitting no more than ~~four~~ two
17 ~~requests~~, encompassing a single purpose listed in this section, ~~for~~
18 ~~Reallocation of Resources Transfer requests~~ during any fiscal year per
19 department. Transfer authority shall further be limited to no more than five
20 percent (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation,
21 funding, and positions specific to each agency. However, there shall be no
22 transfers to or from the County Jail Reimbursement Fund. A Reallocation of
23 Resources Transfer shall be limited to the following specific purposes:
24 a) Costs to open and operate temporary beds;
25 b) Payment of Debt Service;
26 c) Payment of Overtime Expenses;
27 d) Unanticipated increases for medical or private prison contracts;
28 e) Construction/renovation/equipping of new beds;
29 f) Deficits in Farm or Industry Program;
30 g) Losses not covered by insurance proceeds;
31 h) Costs of personnel for critical services or necessary to carry out the
32 mission of the agency.
33 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
34 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
35 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
36 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
 2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly

 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HOLIDAY
 19 COMPENSATION. The Department of Community Correction is authorized to pay
 20 employees for up to ninety-six (96) hours of unused holidays exceeding a
 21 balance in the employee's holiday account of one-hundred fifty (150) hours
 22 following the end of the calendar year. Payments of unused holiday hours must
 23 be processed on or before June 1st in each fiscal year. Employees terminating
 24 employment from the Department of Community Correction will be eligible for
 25 all holiday pay accrued during the years of service. This request is
 26 contingent on approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State after the
 27 Director of the Department of Community Correction has verified that
 28 sufficient revenues are available to make such payments to employees in the
 29 following classifications:

7 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MEDICAL
9 SERVICES - CONTINGENCY POSITIONS. If it has been determined by the Board of
10 Corrections that the Department of Community Correction cannot continue a
11 medical contract with a private provider and the Board deems it necessary to
12 utilize Department staff to provide the required services, the Department is
13 allowed, upon notification of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after
14 seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
15 Committee, to utilize the contingent positions for medical services contained
16 in this Act and make the appropriate transfers from the Professional Fees and

26 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REGULAR
28 SALARIES - CONTINGENT POSITIONS. There is hereby established for the
29 Department of Community Correction - Contingent Positions for the ~~2007-2009~~
30 ~~biennium~~ 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular
31 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
32 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq.), or its
33 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
34 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
35 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification

 23 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY
 25 CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. The appropriations authorized under the
 26 line item established herein for "Community Correction Programs" are to be
 27 used by the Department of Community Correction for establishment and
 28 operation of, to include construction, renovation, and contracting for
 29 establishment and operation of, residential and non-residential community
 30 correction programs such as, but not limited to, community correction
 31 centers, drug, alcohol, and mental health treatments, intensive supervision,
 32 restitution, and others as established and approved by the Board of
 33 Corrections and as may be provided by law.

1 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
3 AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent
4 (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of Community
5 Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item in Section 3 - State
6 Operations to Operating Expense Item ~~(05)~~(04)(A) in Section 3 - State
7 Operations for support of the increase after receiving approval of the Chief
8 Fiscal Officer of the State. Prior to the utilization of the transfer
9 authority a report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
10 Budget Committee including justification for the transfer and the amount of
11 transfer.

12 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
13 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
14 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
15 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
16 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
17 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
18 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more
19 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
20 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
21 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
22 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
23 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
24 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
25 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
26 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
27 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

29 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
31 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Departments of Correction and Community
32 Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare and post
33 on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail
34 reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for
35 verification by the Departments and for payment from the County Jail
36 Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of

1 invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the
2 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end
3 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than
4 three (3) years.

6 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
7 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
8 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
9 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

16 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
18 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
23 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24
25 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
27 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
30 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
32 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
33 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
34 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
35 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
