Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE DISPLAY OF INFORMATION ON THE DANGERS OF SMOKING AT RETAIL SALES COUNTERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


#### Abstract

Subtitle REQUIRING THE DISPLAY OF INFORMATION ON THE DANGERS OF SMOKING AT RETAIL SALES COUNTERS.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-27-227(f), concerning the prohibition of selling cigarettes and other tobacco products to minors and of minors purchasing cigarettes and other tobacco product, is amended to read as follows:
(f)(l) It is unlawful for any person who has been issued a permit or a license under the Arkansas Tobacco Products Tax Act of 1977, § 26-57-201 et seq., to fail to display in a conspicuous place at each retail sales counter or and on each vending machine a sign indicating:
(A) that That the sale of tobacco products to or purchase or possession of tobacco products by a minor is prohibited by law;
(B) That smoking causes lung cancer, heart disease, emphysema, and may complicate pregnancy;
(C) That quitting smoking now greatly reduces serious risks to a person's health; and
(D) The toll-free telephone number of a tobacco cessation treatment provider.
(2) The sign under subdivision (f) (1) of this section shall be at least eight inches by ten inches ( $8^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ ).
