25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-4-418(c), concerning action to be taken
28 by a governing body in response to the findings and recommendations of an
29 audit report, is amended to read as follows:

30 (c) The governing body shall ~~take appropriate~~ adopt a resolution to
31 specifically address corrective action relating to each finding and
32 recommendation contained in the audit report.

34 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 10-4-419(f)(1), concerning disposition
35 reports by the Attorney General and prosecuting attorneys, is amended to read
36 as follows:



1 (f)(1) By June 30 of each year, the Attorney General and each
2 prosecuting attorney to whom the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee has
3 reported a matter under this section shall file with ~~the Legislative Council~~
4 ~~and~~ the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee a disposition report on the
5 status of the matters ~~which~~ that have not been previously reported as
6 resolved to ~~the Legislative Council and~~ the Legislative Joint Auditing
7 Committee.

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
