11 RECEIVING AN AUDIT REPORT TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION  
12 TO ADDRESS CORRECTIVE ACTION; TO REMOVE THE  
13 REQUIREMENT THAT LEGISLATIVE AUDIT DISPOSITION  
14 REPORTS BE FILED WITH THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL;  
15 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

17 TO REQUIRE ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION TO  
18 ADDRESS AUDIT REPORT RECOMMENDATIONS; TO  
19 REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT DISPOSITION  
20 REPORTS BE FILED WITH THE LEGISLATIVE  
21 COUNCIL.  
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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-4-419(f)(1), concerning disposition  
28 reports by the Attorney General and prosecuting attorneys, is amended to read  
29 as follows:

30 (f)(1) By June 30 of each year, the Attorney General and each  
31 prosecuting attorney to whom the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee has  
32 reported a matter under this section shall file with ~~the Legislative Council~~  
33 ~~and~~ the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee a disposition report on the  
34 status of the matters ~~which~~ that have not been previously reported as  
35 resolved to ~~the Legislative Council and~~ the Legislative Joint Auditing  
36 Committee.
