20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-4-419(f)(1), concerning disposition
23 reports by the Attorney General and prosecuting attorneys, is amended to read
24 as follows:

25 (f)(1) By June 30 of each year, the Attorney General and each
26 prosecuting attorney to whom the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee has
27 reported a matter under this section shall file with ~~the Legislative~~
28 ~~Council~~ and the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee a disposition report on
29 the status of the matters ~~which~~ that have not been previously reported as
30 resolved to ~~the Legislative Council~~ and the Legislative Joint Auditing
31 ~~Committee~~.
