SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-116-303 is amended to read as follows: 14-116-303. Members — Nomination and election.

(a)(1) If a water district is composed of all or a portion of four (4) or more counties, then nominations for directors shall be upon petitions signed by at least fifty (50) qualified electors residing in the area of the district from which the director is to be elected. This petition shall be filed with the county board of election commissioners at least sixty (60) days prior to no later than July 1 before the general election.

28 (2) If a water district is composed of all or a portion of less 29 than four (4) counties, then nominations for directors shall be upon 30 petitions signed by at least fifty (50) qualified electors, who shall consist of those electors residing in the part of all or part of any precinct in the 31 32 service area of the customers of the district from which the director is to 33 be elected. This petition shall be filed with the county board of election 34 commissioners at least sixty (60) days prior to no later than July 1 before 35 the general election.

(3) A water district shall file a service area map with the
