## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 27-20-104(b) TO  
10 INCREASE THE AGE REQUIREMENTS FOR MOTORCYCLE  
11 PASSENGERS AND OPERATORS TO WEAR PROTECTIVE  
12 HEADGEAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 TO INCREASE THE AGE REQUIREMENT FOR ALL  
16 MOTORCYCLE PASSENGERS AND OPERATORS TO  
17 WEAR PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-20-104(b), concerning equipment required  
23 for passengers and operators of motorcycles, is amended to read as follows:

24 (b) All passengers and operators of motorcycles, motor-driven cycles,  
25 and motorized bicycles used upon the public streets and highways of this  
26 state shall be equipped with the following equipment under standards set  
27 forth by the Office of Motor Vehicle:

28 (1) Protective headgear unless the person is ~~twenty-one (21)~~  
29 twenty-five (25) years of age or older; and

30 (2) Protective glasses, goggles, or transparent face shields.
