TO PROVIDE THAT A SIGNATURE BY MARK IS BINDING
AND LEGAL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROVIDE THAT A SIGNATURE BY MARK IS
BINDING AND LEGAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 1, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1 is amended
to add a new section to read as follows:

1-1-102. Signature by mark.

In addition to the provisions in §§ 4-3-401, 7-5-305, 7-7-308, 27-14-705, and 28-25-103, a legal signature on a document may be made:

(1) Manually or by means of a device or machine;

(2) By the use of any name, including a trade or assumed name;

or

(3) By a word, mark, or symbol executed or adopted by a person
with present intention to authenticate a writing.
