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16 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Such appropriation as is authorized in this Act which remains at the 18 19 end of the first fiscal year of the biennium may be carried forward into the 20 second fiscal year of the biennium there to be used for the same purposes. 21 Any authorized carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or 22 funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following 23 conditions:

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1 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written 2 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 3 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written 4 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 5 6 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents 7 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 8 Committee; and

9 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include 10 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals 11 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or 12 Institution.

7 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 9 PROVISIONS. The state-supported institution of higher education in this act 10 may transfer appropriations between the various line items within each 11 appropriation contained in this appropriation act. Such transfers shall be 12 made only after the approval of the Department of Higher Education and the 13 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the approval of the Legislative 14 Council.

15 The General Assembly has determined that the institution in this act could 16 be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that institution 17 and that flexibility is being accomplished by providing authority to transfer between items of appropriation made by this act. Since the General Assembly 18 19 has granted the institution broad powers under the transfer of 20 appropriations, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General 21 Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the transfers by requiring 22 prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the transfer 23 authority. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 13 COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act 14 15 shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 16 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 17 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, 18 19 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as 20 21 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said 22 funds. 23 24 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 26 LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds 27 disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act 28 shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was 29 adopted, as evidenced by Initiated Act 1 of 2000, the Agency Requests, 30 Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the

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SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
