## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE  
11 UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS - FORT SMITH FOR THE  
12 FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2010; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS -  
17 FORT SMITH APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
18 2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.  
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21

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
25 the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the  
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be  
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions  
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
34 101), or its successor.

1 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the  
 2 University of Arkansas - Fort Smith for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the  
 3 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as  
 4 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: nine  
 5 hundred ten (910) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of  
 6 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
 7 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
 8 classification.

10 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 11 to the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith, to be payable from the University  
 12 of Arkansas at Fort Smith Fund, for personal services and operating expenses  
 13 of the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith for the fiscal year ending June  
 14 30, 2010, the following:

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30 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 31 the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith, to be payable from cash funds as  
 32 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith,  
 33 for personal services and operating expenses of the University of Arkansas -  
 34 Fort Smith for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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18 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
20 EMPLOYMENT MODELS. The University of Arkansas at Fort Smith is hereby  
21 authorized to experiment with and utilize employment models other than tenure  
22 to accommodate the development and delivery of curriculum, such as the  
23 employment of new faculty on a twelve-month, forty-hour week basis, with  
24 rewards for administrative staff and faculty based upon results.

25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
26 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

28 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
30 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged  
31 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the  
32 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief  
33 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December  
34 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or  
35 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during  
36 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.



1 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the  
2 President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or  
3 upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief  
4 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the  
5 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal  
6 year.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
8 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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10 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
11 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
12 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
13 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
16 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
17 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
18 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
19 with in disbursement of said funds.

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21 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
23 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
28 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
32 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of  
34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
35 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
36 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the

1 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
2 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
3 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
4 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
