15 AN ACT FOR THE PULASKI TECHNICAL
16 COLLEGE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2009-2010
17 FISCAL YEAR.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the Pulaski Technical College for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
33 or its successor.

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29 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the
 30 Pulaski Technical College for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following
 31 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra
 32 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three
 33 hundred (300) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay
 34 not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation
 35 Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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1 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 2 to the Pulaski Technical College, to be payable from the Pulaski Technical
 3 College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Pulaski
 4 Technical College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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19 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 20 the Pulaski Technical College, to be payable from cash funds as defined by
 21 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Pulaski Technical College, for personal
 22 services and operating expenses of the Pulaski Technical College for the
 23 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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5 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
7 PRIORITIES. A high priority of the Pulaski Technical College shall be to
8 provide access to high quality education that promotes student learning and
9 support the economic development of the state.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
11 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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13 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
15 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged
16 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the
17 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief
18 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December
19 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or
20 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during
21 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.
22 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the
23 President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or
24 upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief
25 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the
26 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal
27 year.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
29 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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31 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
32 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
33 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
34 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
36 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures

1 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
2 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
3 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
4 with in disbursement of said funds.

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6 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
8 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
10 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
13 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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15 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
16 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
17 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
18 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
20 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
21 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
22 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
23 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
24 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
25 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
