There is hereby authorized, for the 25 Southern Arkansas University for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following 26 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one 27 thousand eight hundred (1,800) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, 28 29 at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification 30 and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate 31 classification.

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1 TOTAL AMOUNT APPROPRIATED 46,000,000 \$ 2 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TUITION REIMBURSEMENT. The Board of Trustees of Southern Arkansas University shall 5 6 be authorized to reimburse tuition, fees, and other educational related 7 expenses of current faculty who seek additional education levels that will 8 benefit the university in meeting accreditation and professional standards. 9 Reimbursement shall be authorized only when the reimbursement request has been documented by the institution to meet critical shortage instructional 10 11 areas. 12 13 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 14 CONSTRUCTION. The Board of <u>Trustees of the Southern Arkansas University</u> 15 16 shall be included as an exempt institution related to projects exceeding five million dollars (\$5,000,000) provided that the institution shall have adopted 17 policies and procedures involving the awarding and oversight of the contracts 18 for design and construction services in compliance with State Law. 19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July, 1 2009 20 21 through June 30, 2010. 22 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 23 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 25 26 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 27 28 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 29 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 30 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 31 32 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the

President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or 34 upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief 35 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the 36 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal

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year.
The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
<u>2009</u> through June 30, 2009 <u>2010</u>.

SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 5 6 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 7 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 8 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 10 11 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 12 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 13 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 14

16 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 18 19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 20 21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 23 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

25 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 27 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 29 30 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the 31 32 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 33 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 34 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 35 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009. /s/ Joint Budget Committee 36
